

LECTURER IN MASTER OF LAWS PROGRAM

The School of Law at the University of California at Berkeley (Boalt Hall) is now accepting applications for the position of Lecturer in the Master of Laws (LLM) Program. We are seeking to hire one or two instructors. This part-time position is for the 2012-2013 academic year, subject to reappointment yearly based on performance.

LLM Lecturers will teach legal writing, reasoning, research, and oral advocacy skills to foreign-born and educated law graduates attending the one-year Master of Laws program at Berkeley Law. The Lecturer will be responsible for one or two sections (or 20.63% time per section) of the Legal Research and Writing class (approximately 16 to 20 students per section) with the help of student writing coaches. All sections of the class are coordinated, with Lecturers using a uniform syllabus and collaborating in the design of student assignments. We seek applicants who work well independently, yet are also interested in working as part of a team in a collegial and collaborative environment.

Applicants must have a law degree, excellent academic credentials, excellent writing and communication skills, and practical writing experience. Prior teaching of legal writing, moot court or appellate advocacy is desirable. Lecturers teaching this Legal Writing course are paid at \$45,975 (full time), as set by University regulations.

To apply, please submit 1) a resume, 2) a law school transcript, 3) a statement of interest, 4) a sample of written work, and 5) either two letters of reference, or contact information for two references. References should be from persons familiar with your written work and your qualifications for the position.
